This is the 39th year celebrating the Okinawan Festival and second year presenting in a virtual format. Both days will feature an online program filled with Okinawan culture, dance, drumming, food demos and performances from entertainers from Hawaii, Okinawa, Argentina and beyond. "I'm proud that we are still finding ways to stay connected even though we cannot gather in person."
